



## Tourist village Uvala Scott

Uvala Scott is the tourist village located in the Dubno Bay. The beauty of this bay attracted also the English nobleman Alexander Scott, who bought it at the beginning of the 19 th century and decided this was to be the place of his permanent residence, until his death in 1860. Thus the history of this village determined its name. This complex is of pavilion type built in the Mediterranean style surrounded by greenness, which is the heredity of the mysterious Englishman. Namely, he invested considerable amount of his fortune in decorating and planting vegetation in this bay.

The complex offers 298 double bedrooms, 2 hotel suits and 17 apartments (2+2), all of which are connected to the central square as well as main catering objects. The village is spread from the accommodation units providing a fabulous view over the sea, to the walking path along the beach.
